Women's College, and LMS Law College; fulfilling the primary goal of the National Scheme of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA): to convert existing colleges into a cluster university. The university was established under "The Dhanamanjuri University Act, 2017", which came into force on April 6, 2018.
