ELIGIBILITY FOR NEWLY INTRODUCED PG PROGRAMMES

The University will admit students to the postgraduate programmes leading to Master degree from amongst the candidates who passed equivalent examinations from a recognised University/Institute.

The programme wise minimum eligibility criteria and intake capacity are detailed below:

Folkloristics	M.A.	Candidate who holds a Bachelor Degree with 50% marks in aggregate in concerned/allied/ relevant subjects may seek admission to the MA Programme in Folkloristics. The allied/ relevant subjects shall refer to Culture Studies, English, Hindi, Manipuri, Philosophy, History, Sociology, Anthropology, and Performing Arts.	20
Hindi	M.A.	 i. Hindi as Honours or major subject in three years course of BA with 45% marks in aggregate. ii. Hindi as Elective or MIL subject in three years Bachelor Degree Course with 50% marks in aggregate. iii. Any graduate with 50% marks having Ratna, Pragya, Hindi Pravin or any degree certificate in Hindi recognized by the Central Hindi Directorate which is equivalent to B.A. may also seek admission to the M.A. programme in Hindi. 	20
Defence and Strategic Studies	M.A./M.Sc.	 i. Candidates seeking admission to M.A./M.Sc. Defence and Strategic Studies should have passed B.A./B.Sc. Defence Studies (three years undergraduate programme) examination or equivalent from any recognized institution/ University recognized by the UGC with 50% marks in the Honours/Major for unreserved category and 45% marks in the Honours/Major subjects for ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of eminence / Children of Ex Servicemen. ii. B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. in any branch except Music, Dance, Fine Arts and Languages (other than English) 	40
Geology	M.Sc.	BSc (three years undergraduate programme) examination or equivalent from any recognized linstitution / University recognized by the UGC with 50% marks in Geology Honours/ Major for the unreserved (UR) category and 45% marks in the Honours/ Major subjects for ST/ SC/ OBC/ DAP/ Sports candidate of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) OR Candidates who do not have Geology as subject without Honours /Major in the degree examination should offer Geology as one of the electives in the undergraduate level and should secure 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in Geology for unreserved (UR) category and 45% in aggregate and 45% marks in Geology for ST, OBC, DAP Sports candidate of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU)	20
